## Past Simple

We use Past Simple to talk about events that happened in the past:

AFFIRMATIVE			NEGATIVE			QUESTION		
I	walked	1	didn't v	valk	Dic	l I	walk?	
You	walked	You	didn't v	valk	Dic	l You	walk?	
He	walked	He	didn't v	valk	Dic	l He	walk?

We	walked	We	didn't v	valk	Dic	l We	walk?	
You	walked	You	didn't v	valk	Dic	l You	walk?

There are 2 types of verbs:

- **Regular:** the past form of regular verbs is made adding **-ed** (or **-d**)
- Irregular: each irregular verb is different so we must learn them.

<u>To make NEGATIVE sentences</u> we add the auxiliary verb **DID (verb DO in PAST)** and the word **NOT** (didn't) **except** for the verb TO BE (we only add the word NOT > I was an actor/ I was NOT an actor).

## As you can see, there is no S for 3rd person singular (He, She, It) .

<u>To make INTERROGATIVE sentences</u> we also use DID and we change the order of the words: DID + SUBJECT + MAIN VERB + ?

## MUST REMEMBER !!

To make a sentence using the verb TO BE (and other irregular verbs) you have to learn it:

I WAS	/ WASN'T
-------	----------

HE WAS/ WASN'T WE WERE/ WEREN'T

THEY WERE/WEREN'T

- SHE WAS/ WASN'T
- IT WAS/ WASN'T
