"Pieta" and "David" are two Renaissance masterpieces sculpted by...

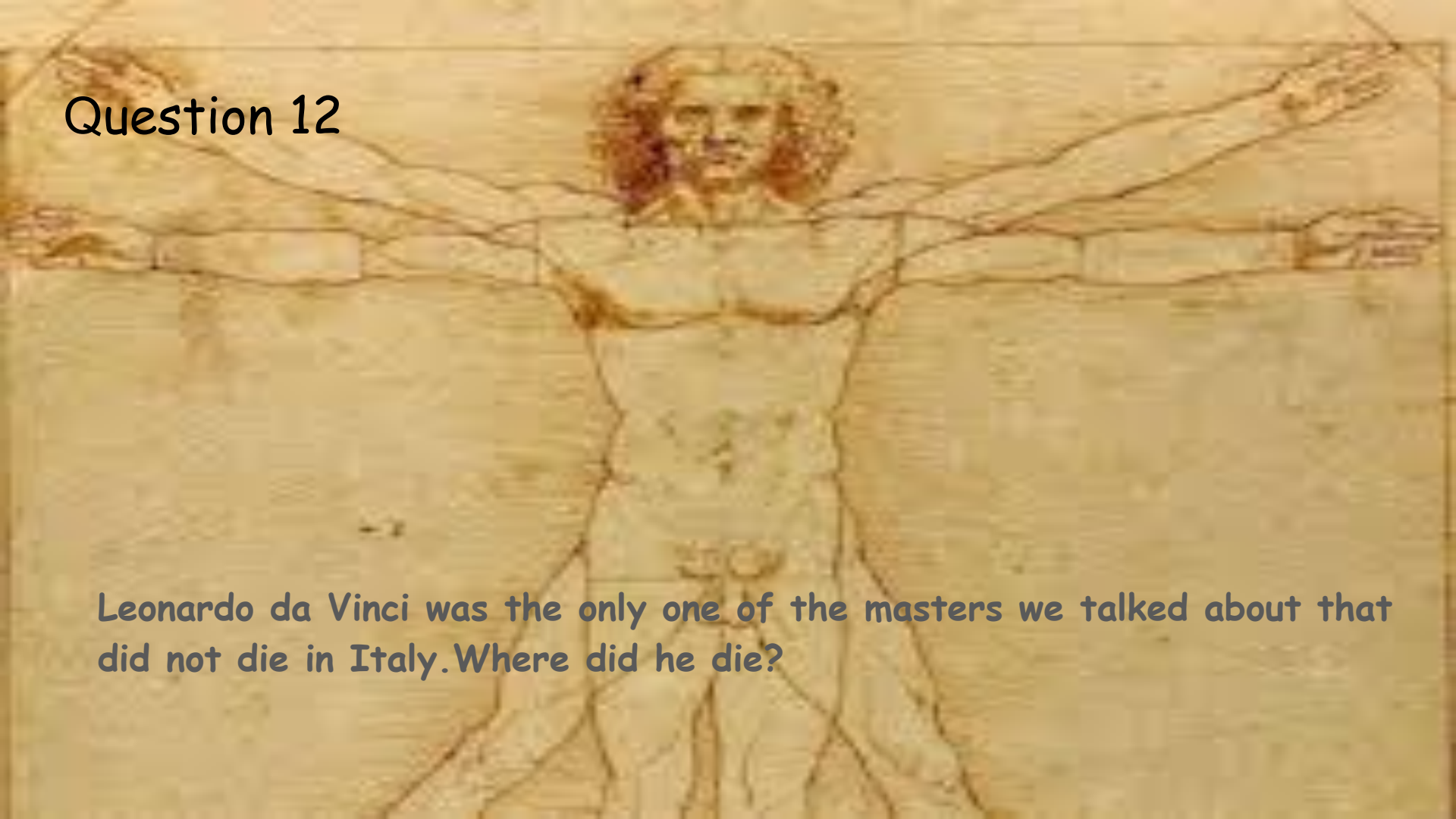
