<b>Adviser</b>	A person who offers advice, expert opinion, or counsel to someone.	Σύμβουλος
<b>Allowance</b>	An amount of money given regularly for a specific purpose or expenses.	Επίδομα / Οικονομική βοήθεια
<b>Boarded up</b>	Covered or closed securely with wooden boards to protect it.	Κλεισμένο με σανίδες
<b>Cascading over</b>	Falling, pouring, or hanging down in large quantities like a waterfall.	Που πέφτει σαν καταρράκτης πάνω από
<b>Clings to</b>	To hold on tightly to something, or to be situated very close to a slope.	Προσκολλάται σε / Είναι σκαρφαλωμένο
<b>Communal</b>	Shared by all members of a community; for common use.	Κοινόχρηστος / Κοινοτικός
<b>Craggy</b>	Rough and rocky; having many steep, rugged, or sharp rocks.	Βραχώδης / Απόκρημνος
<b>Crimson</b>	A rich, deep red color inclining to purple.	Πορφυρός / Κατακόκκινος
<b>Day labourers</b>	Workers who are hired and paid on a daily basis for manual work.	Μεροκαματιάρηδες
<b>Depopulation</b>	A substantial reduction in the population of an area.	Ερήμωση / Μείωση του πληθυσμού
<b>Diversify</b>	To add variety; to expand into new and different sectors or fields.	Διαφοροποιώ / Διευρύνω (οικονομικά)
<b>Drained away</b>	Gradually disappeared, diminished, or moved away from a place.	Εξανεμίστηκε / Έφυγε / Απομακρύνθηκε

<b>Enterprise</b>	A project, business, or company, especially a bold or difficult one.	Επιχείρηση / Εγχείρημα
<b>Fabric of daily life</b>	The essential structure, routine, and core elements of everyday society.	Ο κοινωνικός ιστός / Η καθημερινότητα
<b>Fleeing the war</b>	Running away from a conflict or war zone to find safety.	Που δραπετεύουν / Φεύγουν για να σωθούν από τον πόλεμο
<b>Gravel</b>	Small, loose stones or pebbles used for paths or roads.	Χαλίκι
<b>Humane</b>	Having or showing compassion, sympathy, or consideration for humans.	Ανθρωπιστικός / Ανθρώπινος
<b>Immeasurably</b>	To a degree that is too large or great to be measured; vastly.	Αμέτρητα / Ασύλληπτα / Κατά πολύ
<b>Injected money</b>	Introduced or put a significant amount of money into an economy.	«Εριξε» / Διοχέτευσε χρήματα (στην αγορά)
<b>Languish in limbo</b>	To be forced to stay in an unstable, uncertain, or neglected state for a long time.	Παραμένω στα αζήτητα / Εγκλωβισμένος στην αβεβαιότητα
<b>Mainstay</b>	The most important part of something, providing the main support.	Το στήριγμα / Ο βασικός πυλώνας
<b>Manpower</b>	The total number of people available for work or service; labor force.	Εργατικό δυναμικό / Χέρια εργασίας
<b>Pick up</b>	To learn a new skill or language quickly and without formal effort.	Μαθαίνω γρήγορα / «Αρπάζω» (μια γλώσσα)
<b>Portakabins</b>	Portable, prefabricated cabins used as temporary buildings or housing.	Προκάτ οικίσκοι / Κοντέινερ διαμονής
<b>Roam</b>	To move or travel around randomly over a wide area; wander.	Περιπλανιέμαι

<b>Rusting corrugated iron</b>	Worn, reddish-brown wavy metal sheets affected by rust.	Σκουριασμένη λαμαρίνα (ελαφρώς κυματοειδής)
<b>Settle</b>	To establish a permanent home or place of living.	Εγκαθίσταμαι
<b>Shattered lives</b>	Lives that have been completely broken or ruined by trauma or disaster.	Κατεστραμμένες / Διαλυμένες ζωές
<b>Slaughter yard</b>	A place where animals are butchered; abattoir (used here for a harsh camp).	Σφαγείο
<b>Splashes of shade</b>	Small, scattered areas or patches of cool shadow protected from the sun.	Κηλίδες / Πινελιές σκιών
<b>Toddler</b>	A young child who is just beginning to walk (usually 1-3 years old).	Νήπιο / Παιδάκι που τώρα μαθαίνει να περπατάει
<b>Tucked away</b>	Hidden, secluded, or located in a quiet, safe, or far-off place.	Κρυμμένος / Χωμένος (σε μια ήσυχη γωνιά)
