Array	An impressive display or range of a particular type of thing.	Ποικιλία / Σειρά
At risk of	In a situation where something bad or harmful could happen.	Σε κίνδυνο
Biodegrade	To be decomposed by bacteria or other living organisms.	Βιοδιασπώμαι
Birth defects	Physical or neurological abnormalities present at birth.	Εκ γενετής ανωμαλίες
By volume	According to the amount of space something occupies.	Κατ' όγκο
Campaign	A series of activities intended to achieve a social or political goal.	Εκστρατεία / Καμπάνια
Catwalk	A narrow platform along which models walk to display clothes.	Πασαρέλα
Convince	To cause someone to believe firmly in the truth of something.	Πείθω
Convenient	Fitting in well with a person's needs, activities, and plans.	Βολικός
Crop / Crop failure	A plant grown on a large scale / the failure of a crop to produce a usable harvest.	Σοδειά / Αποτυχία της σοδειάς
Customisation	Modifying something to suit a particular individual or task.	Εξατομίκευση / Προσαρμογή
Cut corners	To do something in the easiest or cheapest way, often ignoring rules.	Κάνω περικοπές / Τσιγκουνεύομαι

Disruptive	Causing or tending to cause disruption or trouble.	Ανατρεπτικός / Προκαλεί αναστάτωση
Drought	A prolonged period of abnormally low rainfall, leading to a shortage of water.	Ξηρασία
Dye	To change the color of cloth or hair using a special substance.	Βάφω / Βαφή
Emergence	The process of coming into view or becoming exposed after being concealed.	Εμφάνιση / Ανάδυση
Exacerbate	To make a problem or bad situation worse.	Επιδεινώνω
Excrete	To separate and expel as waste (e.g., toxins).	Αποβάλλω / Εκκρίνω
Fabric	Cloth produced by weaving or knitting textile fibers.	Υφασμα
Finish (noun)	The final appearance or surface texture of a fabric.	Φινίρισμα
Frequent	Occurring or done on many occasions, in many cases, or in quick succession.	Συχνός

Head out	To leave a place to go somewhere else.	Ξεκινώ / Αναχωρώ
Impact	A marked effect or influence.	Επίδραση / Αντίκτυπος
Impetus	The force that makes something happen more quickly.	Ώθηση / Κίνητρο

Initiative	The ability to assess and initiate things independently; a new plan or strategy.	Πρωτοβουλία
Instrumental	Serving as a key means or agent in something.	Καθοριστικός / Συμβάλλει
Investment	The action or process of investing money for profit or material result.	Επένδυση
Irresistible	Too attractive or tempting to be resisted.	Ακαταμάχητος
Long-established	Having existed for a long time.	Μακροχρόνιος / Καθιερωμένος
Make do and mend	To repair old items rather than buying new ones.	"Μπαλώνω και φτιάχνω"
Minute (adj)	Extremely small.	Μικροσκοπικός / Ελάχιστος
Newness	The state or quality of being new.	Καινότητα / Το καινούριο
Organic	Produced without the use of artificial chemicals.	Οργανικός / Βιολογικός
Pest / Pesticides	A destructive insect or animal / substances used for destroying harmful organisms.	Παράσιτο / Παρασιτοκτόνα
Plant (factory)	A place where industrial manufacturing takes place.	Εργοστάσιο / Μονάδα παραγωγής
Rationalise	To justify behavior or attitudes with logical reasons.	Εξορθολογίζω / Δικαιολογώ
Recycling	Collecting and processing materials to turn them into new products.	Ανακύκλωση
Regular occurrence	Something that happens often or regularly.	Συχνό φαινόμενο
Resistant	Offering resistance to something or someone.	Ανθεκτικός

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Saturated	Supplied beyond the point where demand is satisfied.	Κορεσμένος

Shellfish	An aquatic shelled animal (e.g., mollusk, crustacean).	Οστρακοειδή
Spare a thought	To think about someone in a difficult situation.	Σκέφτομαι κάποιον (με συμπόνια)
Spun	Turned and twisted fibers into yarn or thread.	Κλωσμένος / Γνεσμένος
Sufficient	Enough; adequate.	Επαρκής
Supply chain	The sequence of processes involved in the production and distribution of a commodity.	Εφοδιαστική αλυσίδα
Tackle	To make determined efforts to deal with a problem.	Αντιμετωπίζω (πρόβλημα)
Take action	To do something to achieve a result or deal with a situation.	Αναλαμβάνω δράση
Textile	A type of cloth or woven fabric.	Υφαντό / Ύφασμα
Unintended consequence	A result that was not planned or intended.	Ανεπιθύμητη συνέπεια
Vibrant	Bright and striking in appearance or color.	Ζωηρός / Έντονος
Wastewater treatment plant	A facility where water is treated to remove contaminants.	Μονάδα επεξεργασίας λυμάτων
Woven	Made by interlacing threads or strips of material.	Υφαντός / Πλεγμένος
Yield	An amount produced of an agricultural product.	Απόδοση / Εσοδεία

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
