
# Plurals: 's' 'es'

Plural noun indicates that there is more than one person, animal, place or thing. A singular noun only indicates that there is one.


#### Singular noun




#### **Plural noun**




If the noun is not irregular ad does not in end in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch' or 'sh', we add 's' at the end to make it plural.




If the noun ends in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch' or 'sh', we add 'es' to make it plural.
