**Countable nouns- things, people or places that you can count**



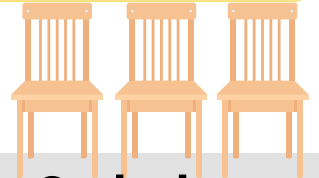

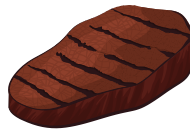
**When nouns are uncountable, they do not have a plural form.**



# Plurals: 's' 'es'







# Plurals

If the noun is not irregular and does not end in 's', 'x', 'z', 'ch' or 'sh', we add 's' at the end to make it plural.

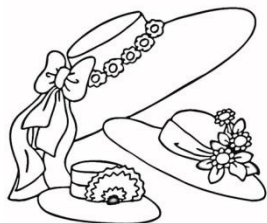
